MOTORSPORT VISION (MSV) OVERVIEW



MotorSport Vision (MSV) is a private UK company owned 75% by its Chief Executive Jonathan Palmer and 25% by Sir Peter Ogden. It is Europe's largest motor racing circuit operator, with six venues in the UK: Brands Hatch, Donington Park, Oulton Park, Snetterton, Cadwell Park and Bedford Autodrome, and a seventh circuit, Circuito de Navarra in northern Spain.

MSV also owns a 1270-acre disused French army base at Couvron in north-east France which is

being redeveloped with a 3.5km new circuit complex, alongside a 750-acre solar park.

MSV's largest project at the moment is redeveloping Donington Hall, a magnificent 62,000 sq ft historic building built in 1791, into a 55-bedroom country house hotel.

MSV is also transforming the adjacent Hastings House building into the state-of-the-art Donington Motorhouse - a prestigious motoring stabling facility. Both due to open in Spring 2026.

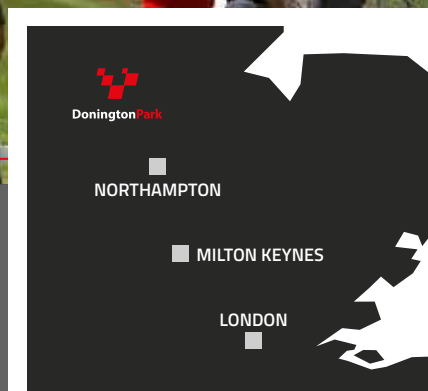
DONINGTON PARK EAST MIDLANDS (LEICESTERSHIRE)



Centrally located in the middle of England, Donington Park was established as a race track back in 1931 when it held its first motorcycle event. Since then Donington has established itself as a leading venue for motorsport and music, having hosted events including MotoGP, World Superbikes, the Download Festival and the legendary 1993 European Formula One Grand Prix.

Location

Donington Park is situated just three miles from the M1 (Junction 23A and 24) and can also be accessed via the A50 (Junction 1) and the A42 (Junction 14). Regular train services operate to East Midlands Parkway (6 miles away), including direct lines to London, while flights to East Midlands (1 mile) and Birmingham (34 miles) International Airports operate throughout the year.



- The circuit is the recognised home for the UK round of World Superbikes, and also regularly hosts major national events for British Touring Cars, British Superbikes, British Truck Racing, British GT and festivals for historic cars and motorcycles
- Donington Park is a key venue for huge music festivals, with Download being held at the venue since 2003, attracting tens of thousands of music fans in June each year
- The circuit is centrally located with excellent transport links across England, and is renowned as one of the UK's favoured fan, driver and rider circuits

Launch Pad Building

Close to adjoining facilities including the Tarmac Lake and Heritage Loop, the Launch Pad Building provides customers with a central base in which to host events connected with these hard standing areas. The facility can accommodate up to 250 guests.

Tarmac Lake & Heritage Loop

A) The Tarmac Lake is a 35,000m² area which can be used for various dynamic driving activities.
 B) The Heritage Loop is a 40,000m² tarmac area with a 1,300m loop which can be used for a number of driving activities.

** The Launch Pad Building can be hired together with these two tarmac areas as the Launch Pad Site.*

Pit Lane Complex

38 garages (all with front and rear lockable doors) are available at no extra cost for all National and GP Circuit events. Paddock 1 is a confined 7000m² space situated to the rear of the garages, which can be used as a presentation area, or simply to park support vehicles.

Garage 39/Pit Lane Suite

Our spacious centrally located restaurant and bar. In addition to the main servery and bar areas, there is a dedicated reception space and separate meeting/break out room available (Pit Lane Suite) - with great access to the garages and pit lane.

Paddocks 2 & 3

Both paddocks can handle a range of driving/riding experiences, in a variety of configurations. Both spaces can also be wetted to offer a low grip surface.

Off Track Areas

The 1200m 4x4 course, 2x Rally Tracks (850m and 750m), and extensive green spaces within the 640-acre site, can be used for a variety of different events and activities including off-road driving, running, cycling, assault pursuits and music festivals.



DONINGTON PARK THE CIRCUIT



Donington Park is one of the most revered circuits in the world, with a sequence of corners and undulations that are among the most challenging in motorsport. The scene of famous performances from racers including Ayrton Senna and Valentino Rossi, Donington features two track configurations; the shorter 1.979 mile National Circuit and the 2.5 mile GP Circuit, both of which pose a unique high-speed challenge in the heart of the English Midlands.

LAUNCH PAD BUILDING



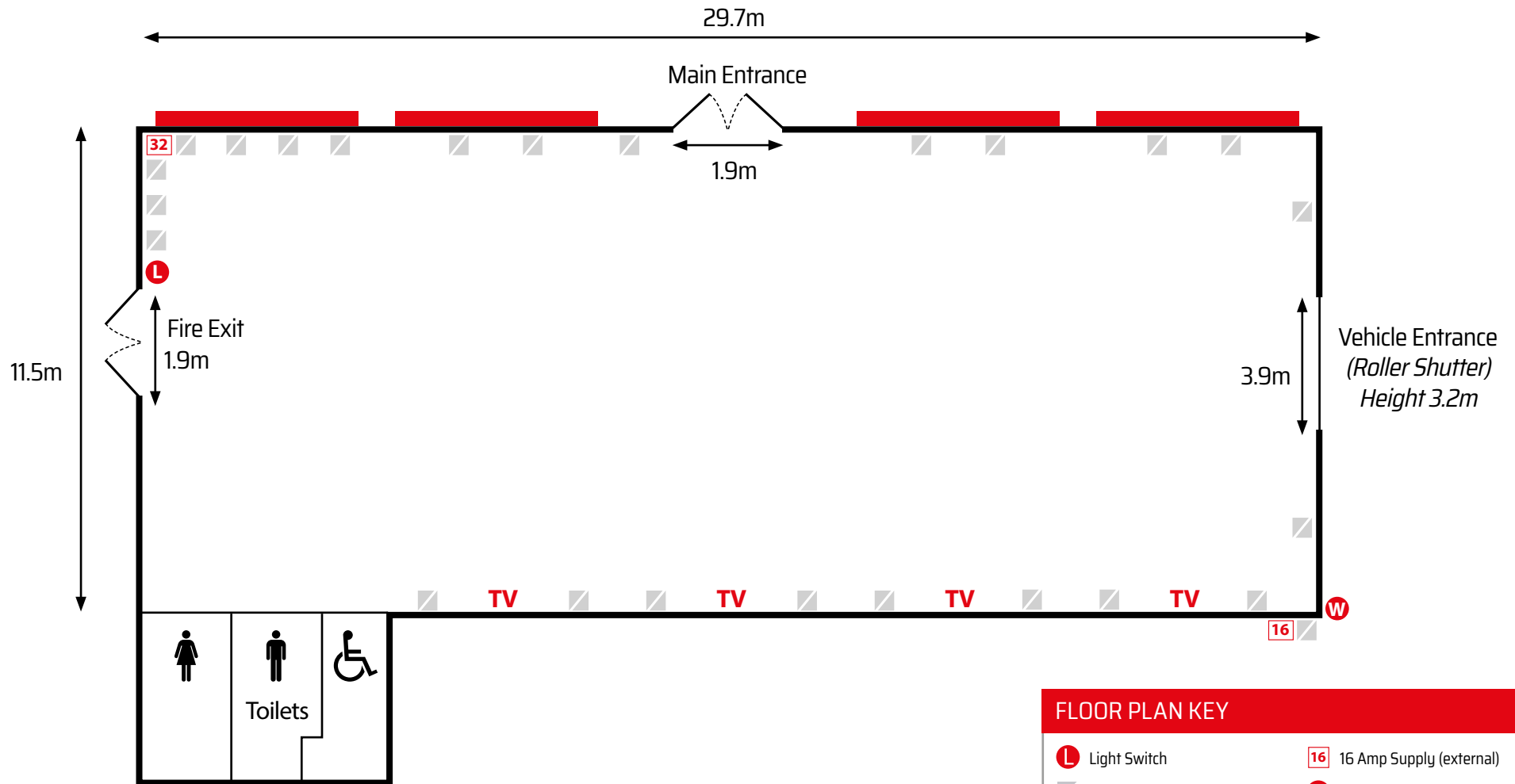
The Launch Pad Building provides 360 square metres of space and is sold as a blank canvas to allow clients to tailor the room to best suit their needs. This facility can be used for anything from parties to manufacturer launches and can be paired with the Tarmac Lake or Heritage Loop areas for automotive activity.

- 360 square metres of blank canvas space
- Vehicle entrance doors to allow manufacturer displays
- Located outside the main circuit perimeter, so ideal for private events

TARMAC LAKE

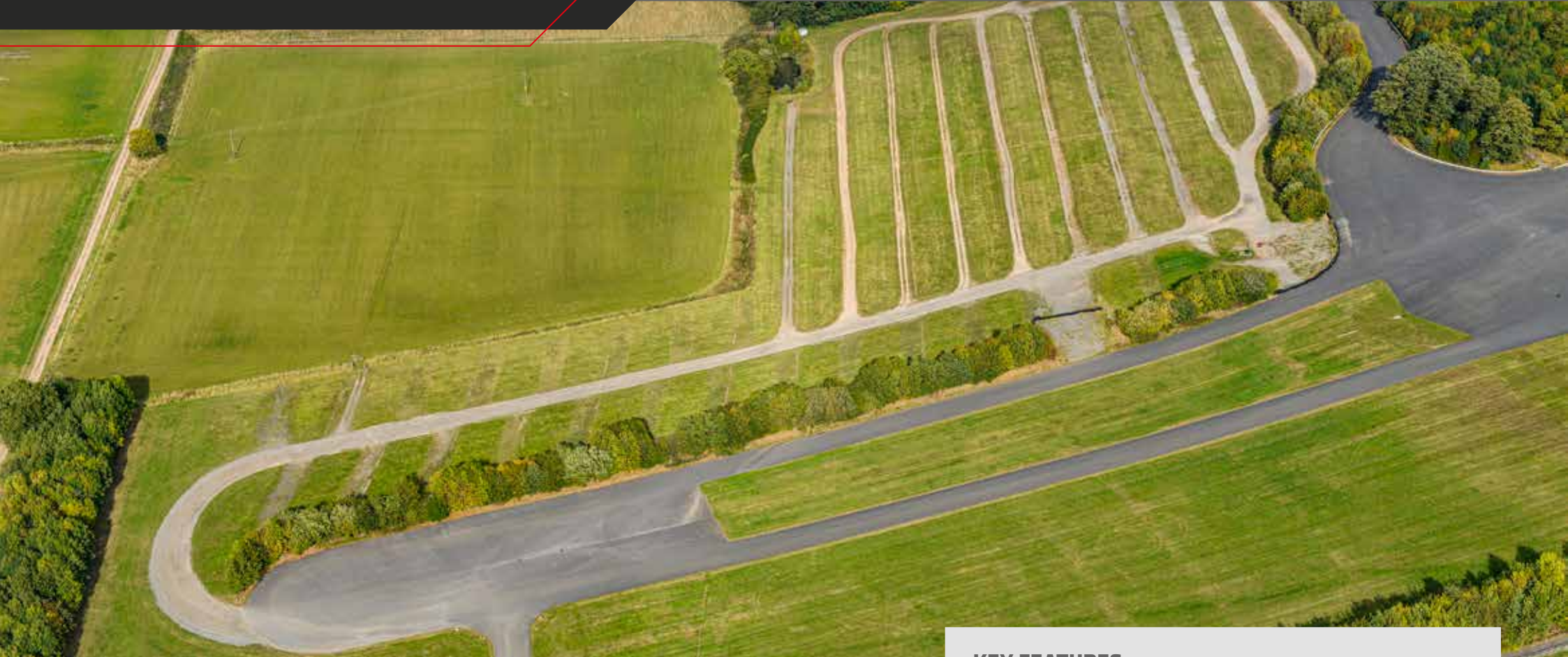


The Tarmac Lake is a vast area of hard standing tarmac located to the west of the venue, and operates separate to the race track. This is an area that has been used previously for large scale pop concerts, as well as numerous driving activities and even outdoor exhibitions and displays.

KEY FEATURES

- 20 acres of tarmac space
- Tarmac is level and very smooth, perfect for driving activities
- Separate to the race circuit
- Can be paired with the Launch Pad Building for indoor space
- Can also be accessed via the Heritage Loop

HERITAGE LOOP



The Heritage Loop is part of the original pre-war Grand Prix circuit, and features a unique layout suitable for all sorts of driving activity. This facility features both flat tarmac areas as well as sections with steep undulations. The Heritage Loop can be operated independently or linked with the Tarmac Lake.

- Numerous layouts and configurations
- Flat areas and sections with undulation
- Separate to the race circuit and ideal for private events
- Can be paired with the Launch Pad Building for indoor space
- Can also be accessed via the Tarmac Lake

PIT LANE COMPLEX



Situated in the middle of the venue, the pit lane complex features 38 garages with direct access to the pit lane and race track, as well as a spacious media suite and expansive tarmacked race paddocks. This facility allows for any kind of automotive events, with indoor space to accompany.

- 38 pit garages (double garage is 8.8m x 10m)

PIT LANE SUITE



Situated in the heart of the venue and adjacent to the Garage 39 Restaurant/Bar, the Pit Lane Suite boasts 139m² of floor to ceiling views overlooking the pit lane with direct access trackside.

The suite offers a range of room layouts and benefits from its own entrance and reception area. Ideal as a conference/presentation space, or exclusive briefing room.

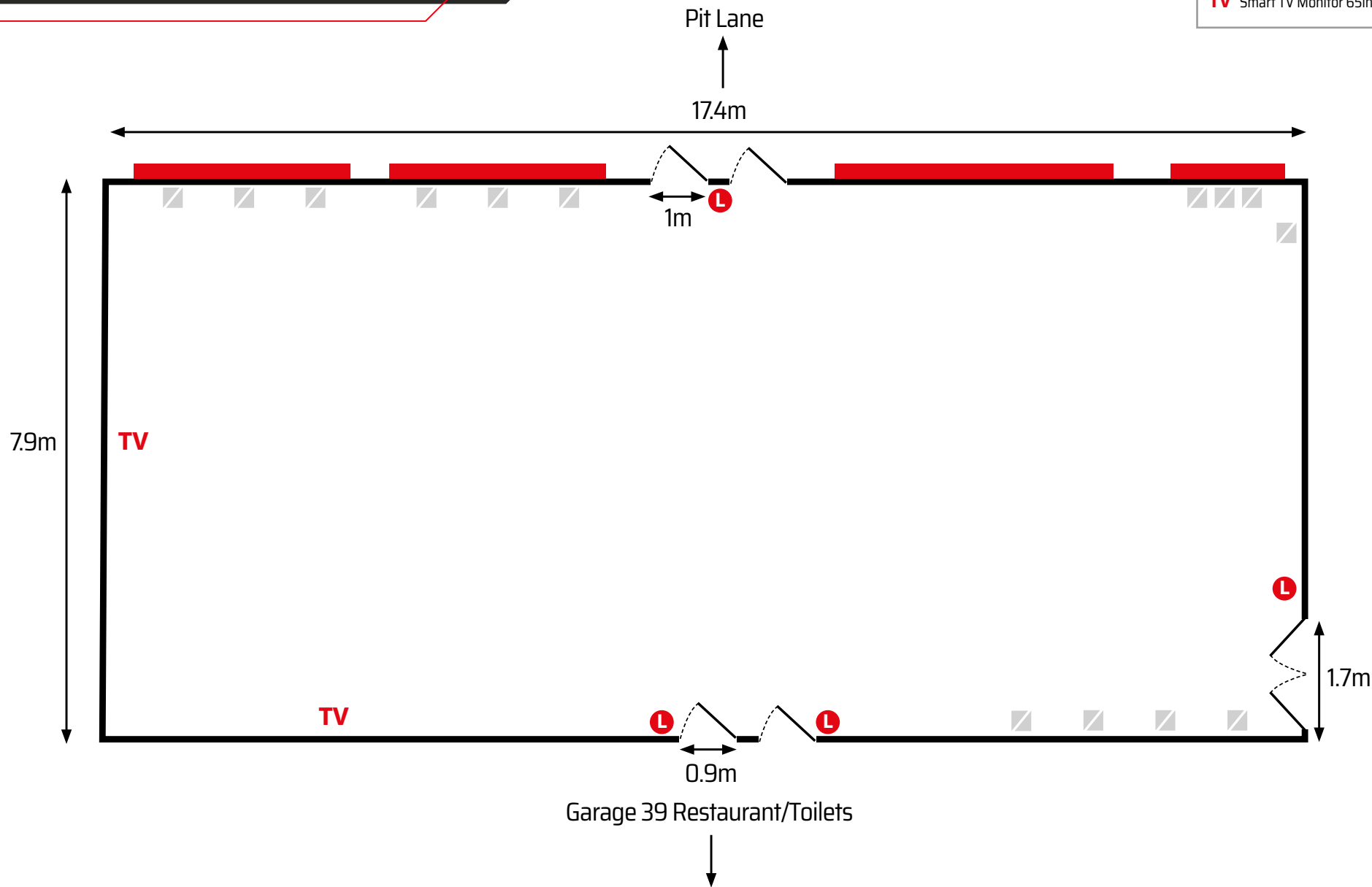

PADDOCKS 2 AND 3



Both paddocks can handle a range of driving/riding experiences, in a variety of configurations. Both spaces can also be wetted to offer a low grip surface. Paddock 2 (19,700m²) is the larger multi-functioning tarmac area and can be utilised for various displays and diverse activities.

KEY FEATURES

- Adjacent to Garage 39, Paddock 2 is suitable for low-speed activity
- At 10,000m² and located next to the Launch Pad Building, Paddock 3 is perfect for display space and additional parking
- Both paddocks are spacious multi-purpose areas, with premium tarmac surfaces

OFF-ROAD AREAS



Designed by industry experts, the all-terrain course at Donington Park is an adaptable off-road space, with a variety of challenging obstacles, climbs and water splashes. It provides a great environment to showcase all types of off-road vehicles, with stunning views of the East Midlands countryside.
