



Admission for carers of disabled guests - important information

Carers of our disabled guests may be entitled to free admission at MSV's race events, however this must be arranged in advance, while online tickets are still available for the event you plan to attend. Carers' tickets cannot be obtained at the venue on the day of the event.

To apply for a free carer ticket, we require any one of the following documents for verification, which is valid for the year you are applying for:

- A copy of the most recent DLA letter for care and/or mobility
- Receipt of Personal Independence Payment (PIP) showing the current entitlement
- A copy of your Attendance Allowance documentation
- A copy of your Access Card (front and back) with a valid +1 symbol

If your application is successful, you will be issued one free carer's ticket in respect of the relevant paying adult, teen or free child.

To apply for a carer ticket, please email carer@msv.com with as much notice as possible. Applications must be received prior to advance ticket sales closing for the event.

Major Event Disabled Parking

Two designated disabled parking areas for those with blue badges can be accessed from the main entrance. Please follow  symbol on highway signage into venue. Places are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis on the day.

Southbank Parking

Limited disabled parking for those with blue badges is also available on Southbank. This area allows visitors to remain in their cars to spectate.

Please follow  symbol on highway signage into venue.

This parking is extremely popular and is available on a first-come, first-served basis on the day. Southbank is a part-gravel, part sloping grass bank and may be unsuitable for wheelchairs or those who are unsteady on their feet. The location is remote, with disabled toilets but no nearby restaurant facilities.

Please note: At Grade D (smaller, club-level) events ALL parking is accessible through the main entrance (only). For a list of Grade D events visit www.msv.com.
