Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.8 Art.1.7.j - Failure to comply with Red Flag signals

Brief Details:

Report received of car 87 overtaking car 14 between red signals displayed at Turns 1 & 2.

Driver of car 87 interviewed who advised that they had been pumping the brakes from Turn 1 due to a braking issue and had gone past car 14 at reduced speed to avoid making contact with the rear of car 14.

Whilst taking the reported mechanical issue into account as a mitigating factor, an overtake under red signals still occurred and a penalty is warranted, albeit reduced down from the guideline for the offence.

Driver of car 87 has been instructed to have their car checked by scrutineer before the second race.
