**Brief Details:**

During the race car 28 and car 50 had contact at T17 resulting in both cars running wide into the gravel.

Car 50 attempted a overtaking move on car 28 after both cars had turned in at T17. Contact was made.

Car 50 is deemed to be at fault for the collision.
