Brief Details:

In the drivers briefing competitors were instructed that at a Safety Car restart race cars must not weave after the bridge on the Wellington Straight. Car 49 was observed to weave 4 times. This was confirmed from the onboard video from Car 24 who was directly behind Car 49. The driver and team manager were interviewed and offered no defence, They were offered sight of video evidence but declined.
