Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Entering Turn 11 car 19 took a wide entry to the corner, whilst Car 3 pulled alongside Car 19's passenger door, Car 19 then tried to take a tight exit from Turn 11 causing side to side contact between the two vehicles.

Car 19 continued and Car 3 spun and continued.

I believe that Car 3 was far enough alongside Car 19 to justify his position, and therefore find Car 19 predominately at fault for the contact.
