Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 222 entered Turn 10 (The Loop) with too much speed for the track conditions which were wet and made heavy left front contact into the right hand side of Car 45. Causing Car 45 to leave the circuit into the gravel trap ending his race. Car 222 continued into Pit Lane.

Car 222 accepted that he was predominately to blame during the judicial hearing.

YouTube Live Stream Footage Onboard footage from Car 222

The onboard footage from Car 45 was corrupt.
