Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

## **Brief Details:**

1st Start - From the start, the right rear was seen to make contact with the front left of Car 19. This caused Car 19 to spin and for multiple collisions to occur behind. Onboard footage was viewed from Car 19 and Car 143 plus Circuit CCTV.

Restart - Approaching Turn 2, Car 143 made constant contact with the rear of Car 5 through Turn 2, this then resulted in Car 143 moving to the right and making significant contact with Car 142, causing a second red Flag. Driver interviewed and onboard footage from Car 143 viewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:
