Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Brief Details:

When driver of car 88 was arriving to the circuit on Saturday he was refused access due to not having a car pass. He proceeded to express his anger at this towards the security guard on the gate using obscenities (NFD). This was reported to us via the security staff to the circuit manager. Upon interviewing the driver he showed remorse and said he apologised to the security person. However he explained that it was his anger at the event not him directly, although he appreciated this could have been misconstrued. I also became aware that the race organisers had not passed the vehicle passes that they had received from MSV. After listening to the driver, him showing remorse and that he had apologised, I mitigated the penalty down to a fine of £100.
