Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Contact report from marshal post 7 that car 51 made contact with rear of 86. Reviewed in car footage from both cars and spoke to both drivers independantly. Could see the closing speed between both cars was quite large, but from in car footage of 86 could see that he was only 0.3 of a second slower than his best lap on entering braking zone. Car 51 carried highg speed into the corner and accepted he would have been unable to make the corner.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Verbal evidence from both drivers separately and also in car footage from both cars, and verbal report from marshal.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from qualifying session and allowed to start from back of grid with 10second delay (if space permits)
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3
