Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Contact occurred on Lap 1 at T12 between cars 3 & 6. Car 6 had one car to their left side and car 3 was in front to the right of car 6. Car 6 is deemed to be at fault for the contact. Car 6 went in too hot into the corner causing the contact. Although the mistake was slight, this was the cause of the contact and the below penalty cited.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage from car 6. Footage from car 3 was available however all parties agreed it would not show anything to add to the investigation. Interview with drivers of car 3 & 6
