Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

During the race, contact occurred between between cars 27 and 77 between T9 and T10. Both cars suffered damage as a result and retired from the race in pit lane.

Car 77 attempted a 'switch back' manoeuvre on car 27 heading out of T9. Car 77 remains straight against the track (noting the white line to drivers right and its relative position). Contact occurred when car 77's front left wheel was approximately in line with car 27's rear right wheel.

Car 27 on drivers left, moves right towards car 77 comparing to the white line on drivers left of the track focusing on the rear camera angle and the rear wing end plate. Although the move was deemed to be minor, the moving is apparent.

For the reason stated above, car 27 is deemed to have be at fault for the contact.

Onboard footage from car 27 (rear) and car 77 (front)
Interview with the drivers and team representatives of car 27 and car 77
Opinion of driving standards advisor Rob Jenkinson and Rob Barff
