Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

During lap 1, contact occurred between cars 32 & 46.

Car 32 came from a long way back behind car 46, braked too late and made contact with car 46.

Car 32 is found to be totally at fault for the contact.

Car 32 has been involved in 3 other incidents of contact this season. One of which resulted in a 3 place grid penalty for car 32. For this reason, the below penalty is cited.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage from car 32 (front) & car 46 (rear)
Interview with the drivers and team representative from car 32 and car 46

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:

5 Place Grid Penalty for the next championship race in which the driver can take the penalty
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3
