Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 21 spun on the track at the exit of Farm (Between Turn 2 and Turn 3). Car 5 avoided the collision on one side of the car and Car 95 avoided the car on the other side. Car 95 left the racing line and rejoined the racing line and made contact with Car 5, causing Car 5 to loose control and hit the barrier on the left hand side. Car 95 caused the incident by not expecting Car 5 to be on the racing line and looking carefully when moving across the track and admitted it was his fault.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Both drivers interviewed.
Live feed from Ferrari.
Video from Car 20 which was following cars.
