Brief Details:

During post qualifying checks, car 143 was found to have the ABS sensors connected. This contrary to championship reg 16.2, page 27. This is accepted by Christopher and no mitigating circumstances were offered.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Competitors Practice Times disallowed and subject to re-scrutineering. Competitor permitted to start from the back of the grid (if space permits)

Additional Comments: Subject to infringement being rectified, car 143 is permitted to start the race. In accordance with NCR Ch2, App6, art 5.5e, car 143 is required to start the race from the pit lane on the first racing lap
