**Brief Details:**

Entering turn 14 (as stated in the drivers briefing documents), car 46 was on the right side of car 28 entering the corner. Car 46 was on slicks and car 28 was on wets in damp conditions. Car 46 had slight oversteer and contact with the rear wheel of car 28 causing car 28 to spin into the gravel.
