Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 2 left the circuit on the inside of the last corner on the last lap, crossing over the kerb and across the track. This blocked Car 24 from taking the normal line through the corner and both cars ended up on the grass on the outside of the corner. Car 24 was able to rejoin but Car 2 stalled and remained there.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard video, circuit CCTV, driver of Car 2 was interviewed.
