Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

## **Brief Details:**

Towards the end of the race, car 9 (Peter Erceg) made contact with car 99 (Marc Elman), from which both cars retired from the race. From viewing in car footage from car 88 (following) and car 9, it can be seen that car 99 was several car lengths ahead and turning into the corner. The contact was in to the front part of the side of the car. Driver of car 9 stated that he thought car 99 had seen him but by the time he realised that he had not he was already committed to the move. The car was also checked to confirm that there was not brake concerns.

## Evidence Relied Upon:

Interview of driver, Peter Erceg, along with his team manger. And a review of in car footage from car 9 and 88
