Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Marshal Post 9.5 reported contact between Car 25 and Car 68 at Turn 8 (Clearways) on the last lap of the race during Race 3 (Final) on Saturday 28/06/25. Car 25 made contact with the right hand side of Car 68, causing Car 68 to spin and roll several times, coming to a rest against the barrier upside down in the gravel trap. Circuit CCTV and onboard footage was viewed from Car 68 and Car 25 and both drivers were interviewed. After considering all the evidence I find Car 25 to be at fault for causing the contact.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:
