Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

**Brief Details:**

During Race 1 (Heat 1) on lap 3, Car 12 locked up when entering Hislop Chicane (Knickerbrook In) causing them to go stright on through the chicane. Car 3 was on the outside (left handside) of Car 12 and due to Car 12 going straight on, was forced to do the same, losing multiple positions. Both drivers were interviewed, Circuit CCTV and onboard from Car 12 and Car 3 viewed. I percieve Car 12 to have the appearance of a lack of control over the car during this incident.
