Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.8 Art.1.7.e/f Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

Brief Details:

A report of a car 44 (Will Cox) overtaking car 70 (Paul Hutson) between marshal posts 2A (Banking In) and 3 (Banking Out) was received by race control, and followed up with a written report.

Both drivers were summoned to a hearing, where the written report from marshal post 3 and video from both competitors was reviewed.

From discussion with both drivers, it was apparent that car 70 pulled to the left hand side of the circuit as he entered the single yellow zone to let car 44 past, as he was in a different class and much quicker.

After hearing evidence from both drivers, the following decision has been made:

- Car 44 receives a formal reprimand, for overtaking through a yellow flag zone.
- Car 70 receives a verbal warning, for manoeuvring in such a way that the overtake was effectively encouraged.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Written report from marshal post 3, video from both drivers.
