Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Truck 89 and Truck 44 spin on the entry to Turn 2 on Lap 1. Truck 42 makes contact with Truck 89, continues to drive through the corner with both trucks sideways. On the exit of Turn 2, Truck 42 makes contact with Truck 83, forcing Truck 83 off the track and into the barrier. Truck 83 retires from the race.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Spoken to drivers of Trucks 42, 44, 83 and 89.
Reviewed video from Trucks 29 and 42.
