Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

**Brief Details:**

On approach to Brooklands car 55 attempted to overtake car 78, in the belief there was space. Contact was made and the driver believed that 78 had turned across him. On reviewing the incar footage, i could see that car 55 never had an overlap on entering the corner and made firm contact with the left rear of 78 causing the car to spin out. Car 78 failed to finish. I was unable to find any mitigating circumstances to lower the penalty from disqualification.

**Evidence Relied Upon:**

In car footage from 55.
