Brief Details:

Report from marshal post 4.0 that car 27 (Barrington Darcy) made contact with car 52 (Darren Labbatt) causing both cars to retire. Interview with driver 27 and reviewed the on board which showed the move was from a long way back and that there was no overlap before car 52 was well into the corner. Live stream also viewed but cleared images from on board.
