Brief Details:

During the race on lap 1 car 4 and 14 made contact at turn 1.

I deem car 4 to be at fault for the contact. Car 14 appeared to brake in a reasonable and predictable location and committed to a line. Car 4 did not brake early enough and/or hard enough to avoid the car ahead.
