## **Brief Details:**

During session car 4 was reported as overtaking car 53 at marshal post 1.3, before marshal post 2.0. Reviewed on circuit CCTV which confirmed the moved but showed a much slower car. Driver reported to clerk that he was aware what happened but when he saw the slower car he was too close to avoid overtaking and he considered it dangerous to avoid overtaking. He apologised for what happened. The drivers version of events was exactly the same as the CCTV verified. Action mitigated down to formal reprimand.
