Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 111 (Grant Gibson) made side to side contact R/H side of Car 111 to L/H side of Car 28 (John Owen) during Sports 2000 Race 1. Both cars continued. Both drivers interviewed following the race and onboard video from front and rear cameras on Car 28. Driver of Car 111 had already spoken with the driver of Car 28 and apologised for the contact directly after the race.

Driver of Car 111 advised by the clerk with regard to the need to avoid contact which was willing accepted. Both drivers advised of Right of Appeal and decision timed at 17.37hrs

Evidence Relied Upon:

On-board video evidence from Car 28.
