Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 96 made Front L/H contact with R/H side of Car 17 at Post 13 between Brooklands and Luffield during Race 1 Sports 2000, causing Car 17 to spin and lose track position. Both cars continued.
Both drivers interviewed and on board video from car 17 viewed by both parties. Decision of 8 sec time penalty for car 96 to be added to race time. Decision given verbally to both drivers at 9.26 hrs Sunday 20th April when video evidence became available.
