No Further Action

Contact Front of Car 40 (Tim Tudor) into rear of Car 82 (Ben Cater) @ 16.15hrs in Sports 2000 Race 1 between Post 4.8 and Post 5.0 resulting in Car 82 veering to R/H side of track and making heavy contact with Barrier, and car 82 being partly on circuit with debris on centre of track. Driver out unaided to place of safety but required Medical checks at scene. Race Red Flagged Immediately and Rescue Unit and Medical Car scrambled to scene. Driver of Car 82 taken to Medical Centre for checks and subsequently released K19 at 17.07hrs. Car 40 continued on circuit. Both drivers interviewed and frontal on board video from Car 40 seen by both drivers and verbal statements from both drivers received in the presence of both parties. On Board video showed that both cars were switching track position moving side to side in very close proximity on a fast section of the circuit, resulting in light contact of nose of Car 40 against exhaust of Car 82, resulting in car 82 leaving the track. On review of the video and the statements from both drivers I find that no one driver was wholly or predominately responsible for the incident and hence consider this to be a racing incident.

Both drivers advised of the Clerk's decision at 17.31 together with their Right of Appeal.
