Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

**Brief Details:**

During the race, contact occurred between cars 3 & 8 at T9.  
Car 8 is found to have left sufficient room on the right hand apex for car 3, however car 3 'washed out' with understeer causing the contact with car 8.

Car 3 is found to be at fault for the incident and the below penalty cited.

Onboard footage from car 3 & 8  
Interview with the drivers and team representatives (whom are also the drivers guardians) from cars 3 & 8
