Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

The drivers of Car 9 (Megan Bruce) and Car 55 (Ava Dobson) were interviewed by the Clerk of the Course with the Guardian/Team rep following a collision between the two cars at T 9/T10. Megan Bruce admitted that she realised having committed to an overtake realised on braking that the move was ambitious and that she could not avoid the collision with Car 55 and admitted responsibility for causing the collision.
